LISC JACKSONVILLE POSTS UPDATED WEBSITE IN CELEBRATION OF ITS 10TH ANNIVERSARY

Jacksonville, FL (March 4, 2009) --- LISC Jacksonville (Local Initiatives Support Corporation Jacksonville) is celebrating its 10th anniversary with an update of www.liscjacksonville.org . To commemorate its success in helping to create a community development corporation (CDC) industry in Jacksonville as well as rebuilding neighborhoods, the nonprofit has redesigned its website. The new website features a timeline of the history of the organization in Jacksonville. Also included are links to the CDCs it supports and explanations of the type of assistance it offers to these community nonprofits.

“The last decade has seen tremendous change in community development in Jacksonville,” said LISC Jacksonville Executive Director Joni Foster. “We wanted our new website to reflect that growth while continuing to educate people on the work that is being conducted in the revitalization of distressed neighborhoods.”

The redesign of the website is just one of several projects LISC Jacksonville is planning to celebrate its 10th anniversary. The organization plans to sponsor the Downtown ArtWalk on June 3. During ArtWalk it plans to display photography taken by youth living in the neighborhood the LISC Jacksonville community development corporations serve.
